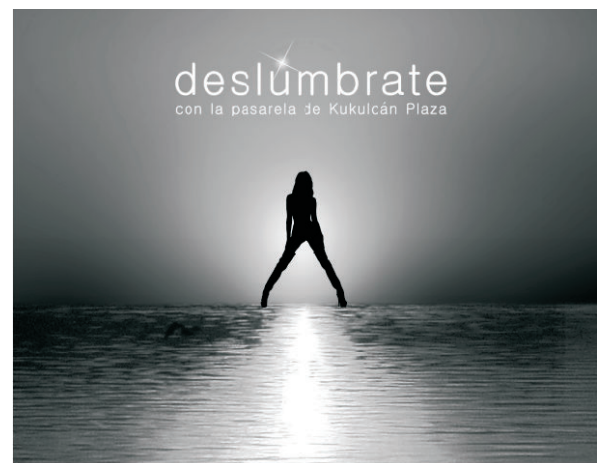

Time in the Home for the Elderly: María is one of the newer residents, she has only been in the home for three months, but has made an excellent transition and is very happy.

Likes: Until a few years ago, María loved to cook, especially cakes, puddings, cookies and doughnuts. Now that she is not able to walk on her own, María still likes to be as active as possible. She loves to read, especially Latin American authors, and also to write. She doesn't keep any of her writings, but loves to talk about her ideas with friends and visitors, and has developed some interesting points of view on life and death.

Dislikes: María doesn't like to feel that she is sick; the feeling of impotence makes her sad.

El Hogar de los Ancianos is the only residential home for the elderly in the north of the state of Quintana Roo. The goal of the home is to provide a dignified and healthy environment for needy elderly to live. The home provides round-the-clock care for about 30 full-time residents at a time.

Several residents of the Hogar de los Ancianos were found wandering the streets of Cancun and have no family members to care for them. Other residents come from families with limited resources that cannot care adequately for them.

The International Women's Club of Cancun has supported El Hogar de los Ancianos through donations of needed items and with our visits for the past two years.
